What forms should be used for one-time application?

Different forms are provided for use by different types of specified persons.

Form PS1

Application for Disclosure of Withheld Information / Protected Information (By data subject / person authorized in writing by a data subject / member of the data subject's company)

Form PS2

Application for Disclosure of Withheld Information / Protected Information (By liquidator / trustee in bankruptcy / public officer or public body/scheduled person)

Form PS3

Application for Disclosure of Withheld Information / Protected Information (By solicitor or foreign lawyer / certified public accountant (practising) /financial institution or DNFBP)

supporting What documents required for the: applications?

In general, the supporting documents required for the applications are relating to the identification documents applicant, evidence of the capacity of the applicant and authorisation letter issued by the specified person in case the specified person is other than a natural person.

What is the WI / PI Search Services for subscription by a User Account?

To facilitate timely access to WI / PI for designated types of specified person who will need to obtain WI / PI for the performance of their duties, these designated types of specified persons can apply for disclosure of WI / PI online through the WI / PI Search Services at the e-Services Portal (www.e-services.cr.gov.hk) of the Registry using their User Accounts.

How to Obtain Withheld Information / Protected Information

What is Protected Information ("PI")?

PI refers to the usual residential addresses and full identification numbers of directors of companies, and full identification numbers of company secretaries and some other individuals (such as liquidators and provisional liquidators) contained in documents delivered to the Companies Registry ("the Registry") for registration on or after 24 October 2022.

What is Withheld Information ("WI")?

WI refers to the usual residential address and full identification number which are contained in a document delivered to the Registry for registration under the Companies Ordinance (Cap. 622) ("CO"), the Companies (Winding Up and Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance (Cap. 32) or the Companies Ordinance (Cap. 32) as in force from time to time before the commencement of the CO, and are withheld from public inspection by the Registrar of Companies upon an application made under section 49(1) of the CO.

Who can Apply for Disclosure of WI / PI?

Sections 8(1) and 12(1) of the Companies (Residential Addresses and Identification Numbers) Regulation (Cap. 622N) ("the Regulation") (https://www.elegislation.gov.hk/hk/cap622N) specify the following persons who can apply to the Registry for access to WI / PI:

a member of the data subject's company a data subject a person who is authorized in writing by a data subject a public officer / public body a liquidator a trustee in bankruptcy scheduled persons a solicitor / foreign lawyer a certified public accountant a financial institution / designated non-financial businesses and professions (DNFBP) (practising)
